



Costs of Certificates and Diplomas of Positive Psychotherapy

Below you find the costs (all in Euro) for the certificates to be paid to the World Association for Positive Psychotherapy (WAPP). It is based on the categories of the World Bank regarding the economic situation of a country (for further information see next page). In addition to this fee, the local organizer will charge a participation fee for each seminar.

WAPP members who have paid their membership fees for the year in which they complete their training get a 25 Euro discount on Master Training Certificate and European Certified PPT Training certificate part II.

The fees for Master Training Certificate and European Certified PPT Training certificate - as indicated below - include membership in WAPP for the calendar year of graduation.

Please note that until further notice all Eastern European countries, which are listed by the World Bank as category A countries, will be counted as category B countries (due to the economic situation of January 2025).
